The Hudson County Park Commission was founded in 1903 after the state legislature passed a law in 1902 enabling park boards to finance public parks by issuing bonds. Lincoln Park was begun in 1904; the assemblage of park lands caused homes on West Side, Belmont, Communipaw and Bentley Avenues to be sold and moved. The park main entrance is on Belmont Ave. and J.F. Kennedy Boulevard, where a formal square ends in 2 shelters (Map # 1); at the head of the park is the bronze statue of Abraham Lincoln, "The Statesman," by James Earle Fraser (Map # 1), presented to the county by the Lincoln Association in 1930, after which the park was renamed; an upland, formal section with level ground is between West Side, Belvidere and Delaware Aves, and has as its focal point a 53' high fountain (Map # 3), designed by Pierre J. Cheron, 1907-1911. The cast plaster, iron reinforced, 365-ton fountain is on direct axis to the main approach of the park, and has 7 allegorical heads and 27 other spouts cast in Paris by American sculptor Bernice Francis Langton. 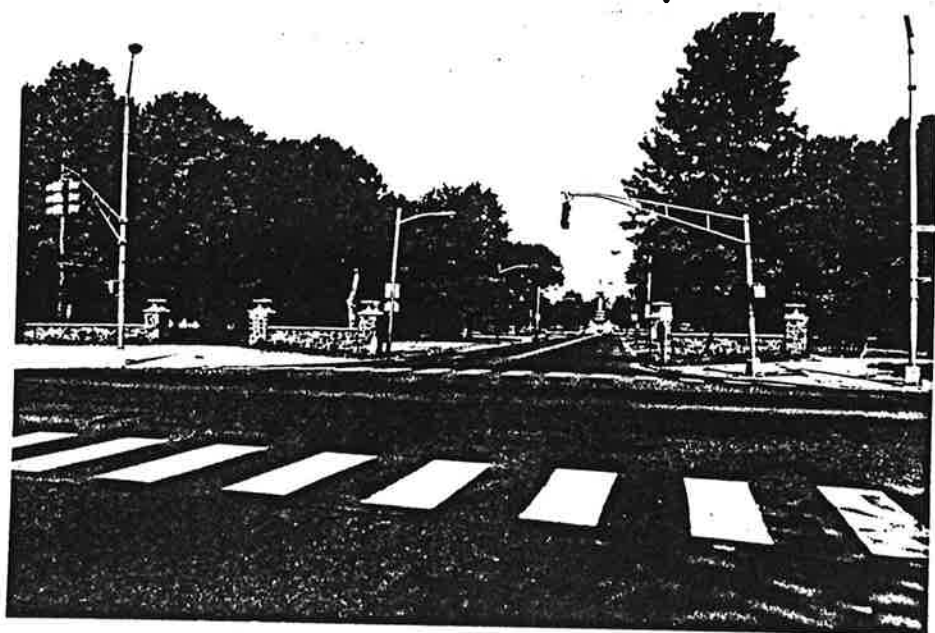

	Abraham Lincoln Memorial Park, (continued)					<p>Continuous gravelled paths and driveways unite the various sections of the park; the low-lying upland meadow offers a more picturesque vista, in contrast to the formally-planted areas formerly mentioned. The park includes a major water feature, Edgewood Pond (Map # 5), in addition to 18 tennis courts, 5 baseball diamonds, a children's playground, and wading pool (Map # 6). An octagonal, 1 story bandstand (1909) is open-air, with a molded basecourse, bluestone steps, Indiana limestone columns, and a terra cotta roof, exemplary of the permanent appearance intended by the park planners. Daniel W. Langton was the first landscape architect engaged in designing the park; after his death in 1909, Charles N. 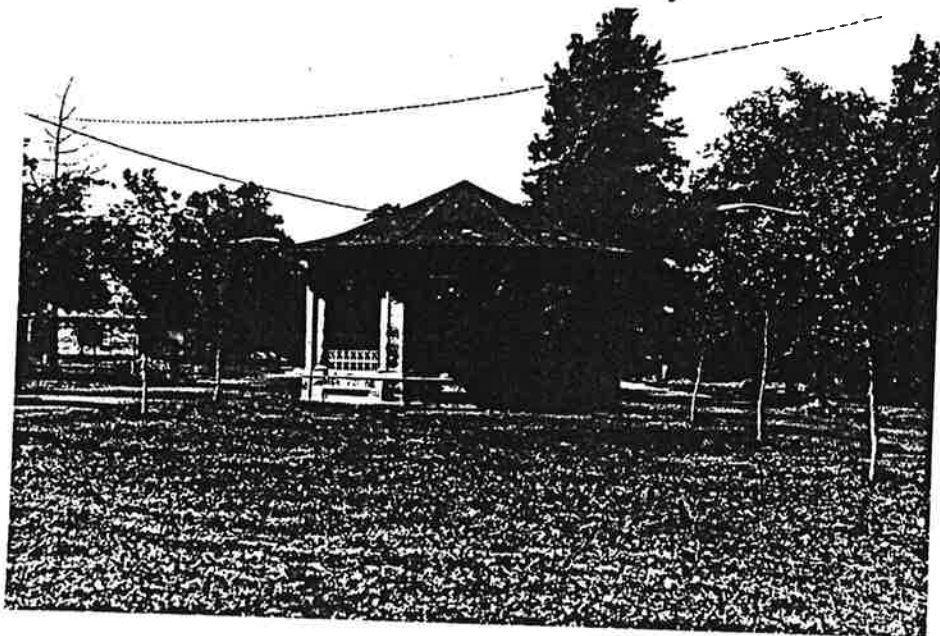
