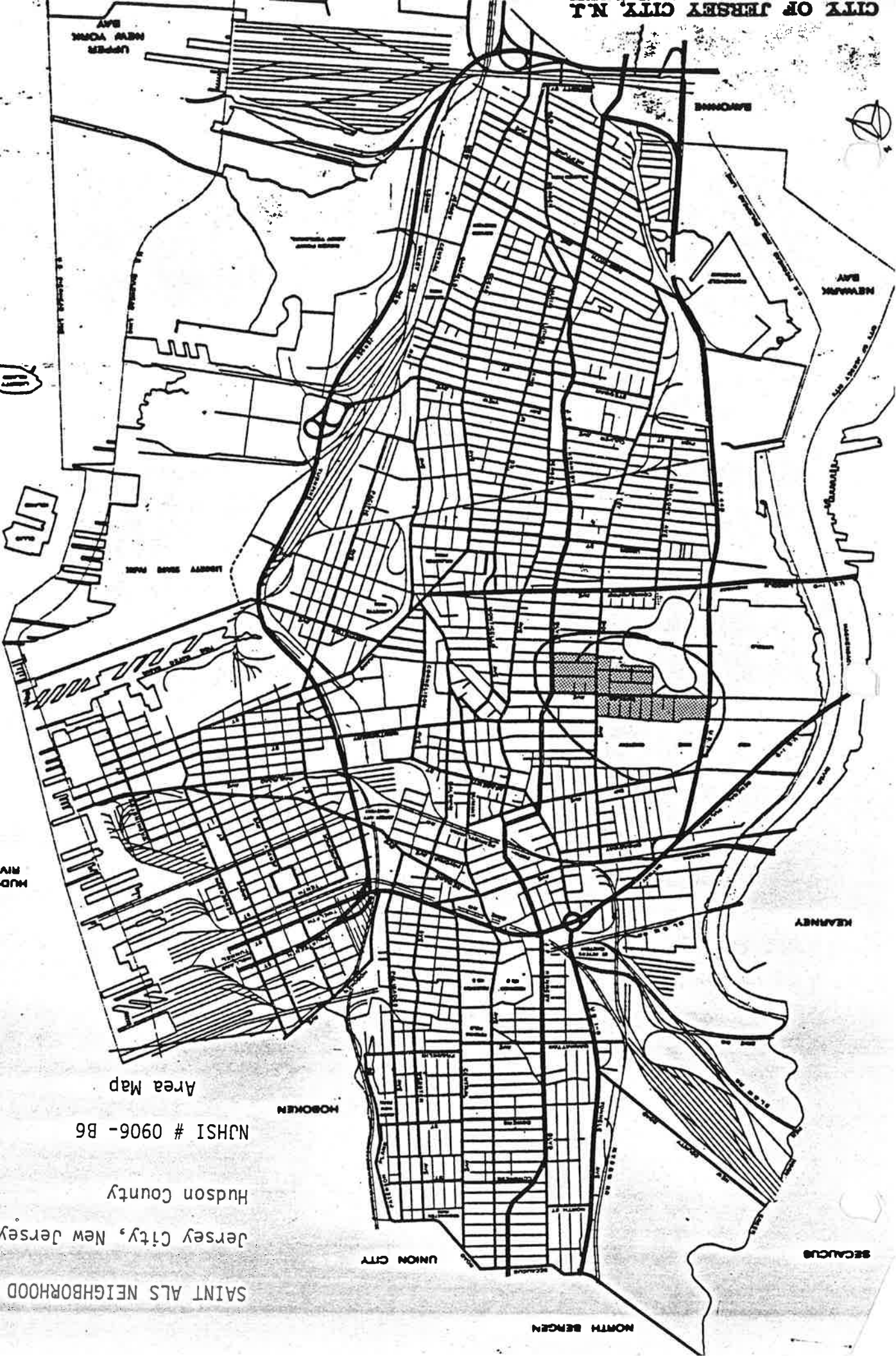

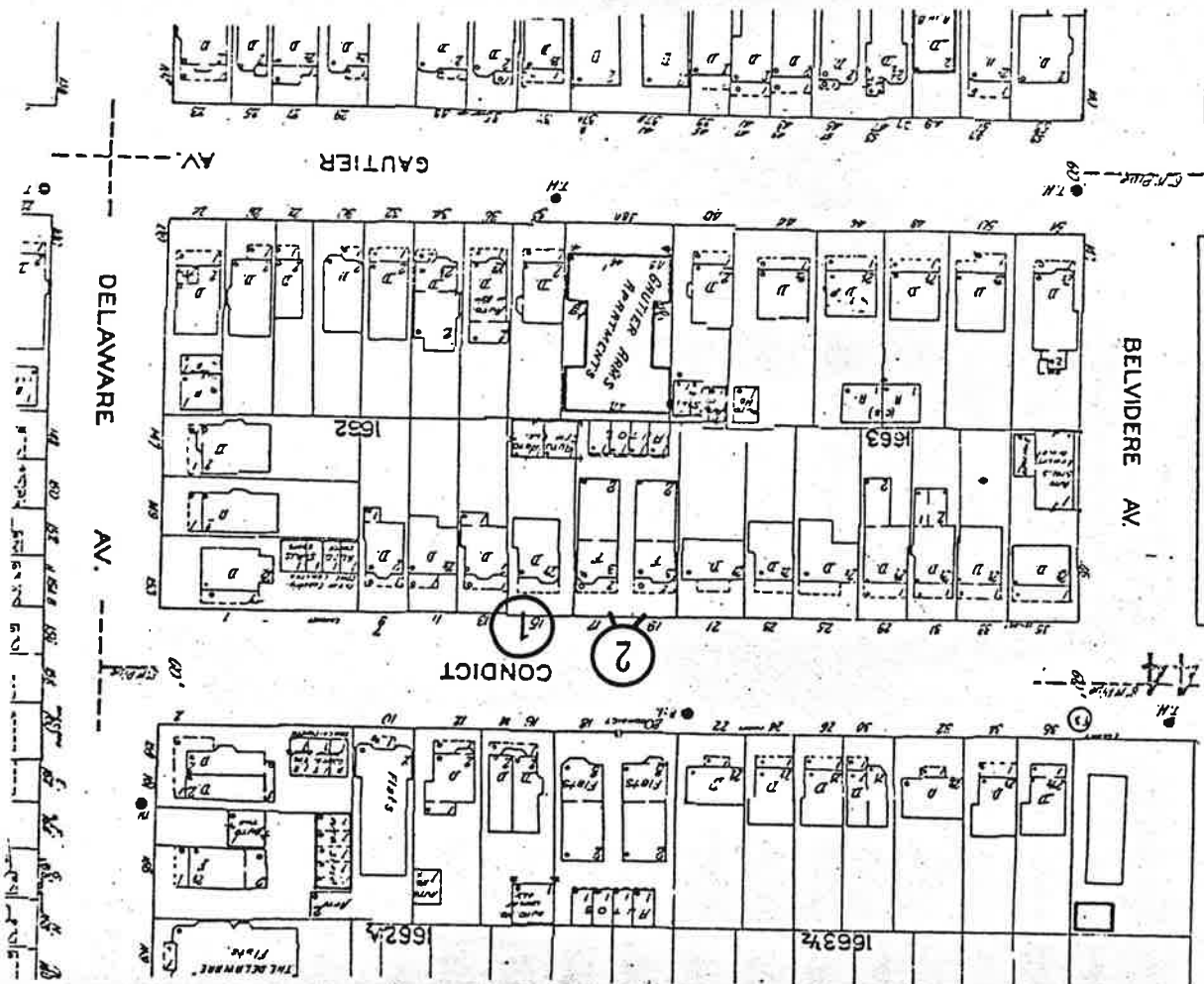

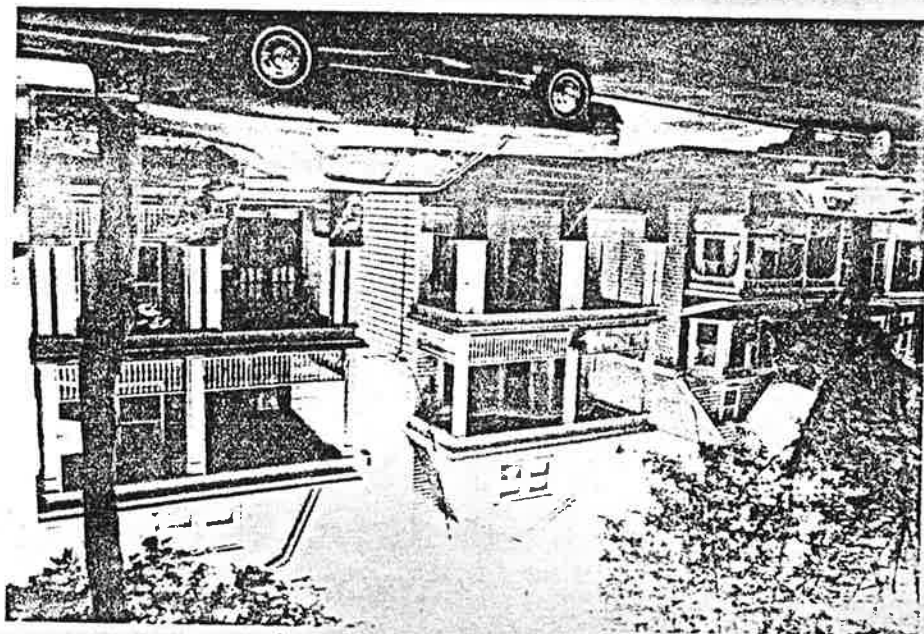

	Condict Avenue General Streetscape		N	R	The two block area on the north and south side of Condict Avenue between Mallory and Delaware Avenues contains houses which are set back, frame, 2-3 stories and the majority have porches. Styles range from Vernacular, Queen Anne, to early 20th Century Colonial Revival. The majority of the buildings in this area of Ward B were built between 1896 to 1908 and they have undergone considerable alterations through the years. #'s 15-19 Condict Avenue are the least altered examples. #15 dates to the earliest period of building (1896-1908). #'s 17 and 19 date to the 1920's and were built as infill residences after the street grid pattern was changed in this area. They are located on the former site of Olean Avenue which was a north-south roadway originally extending northward to Duncan Avenue. Formerly Belvidere and Nunda Avenues also extended northward across Condict Avenue to Duncan Avenue.	Contact 201/29

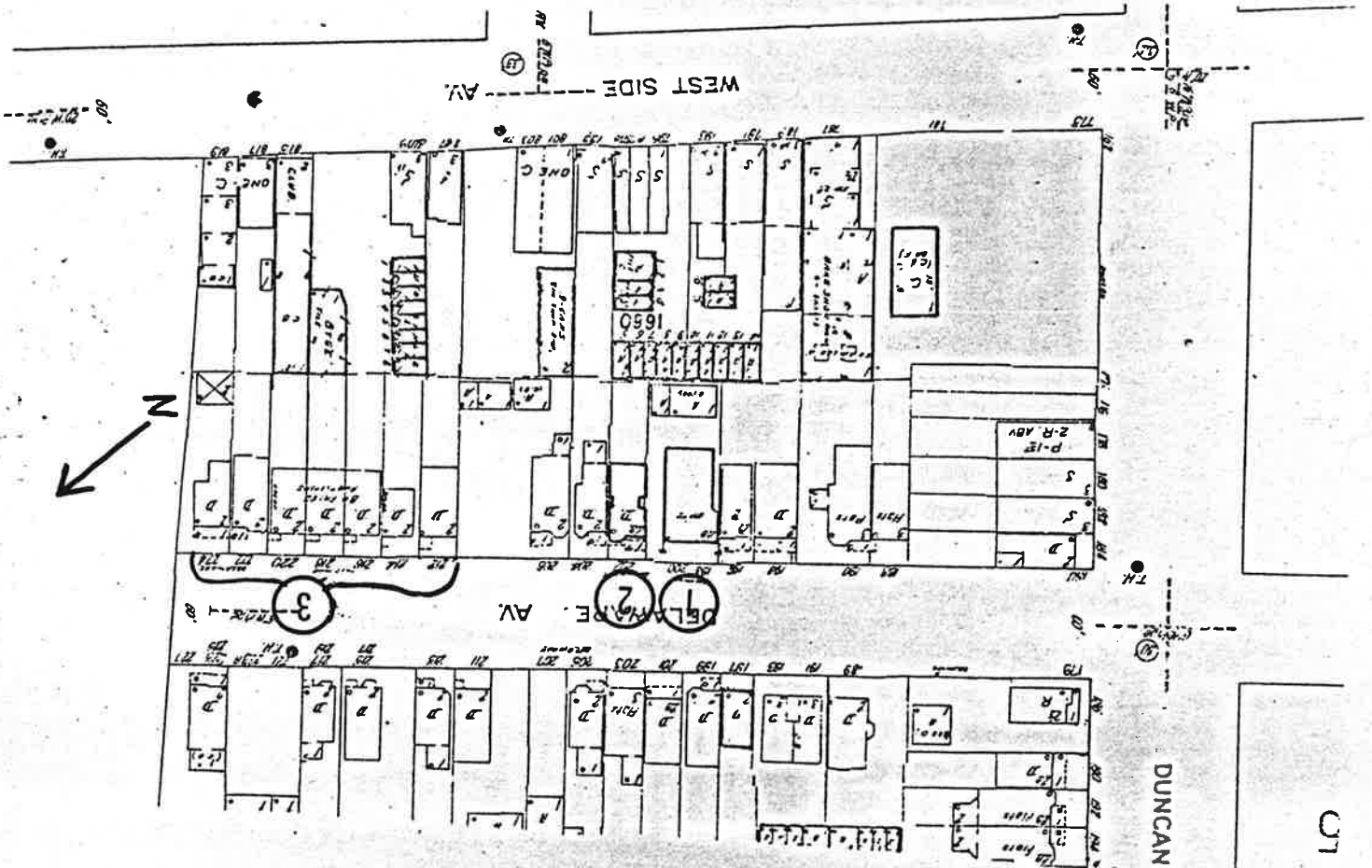

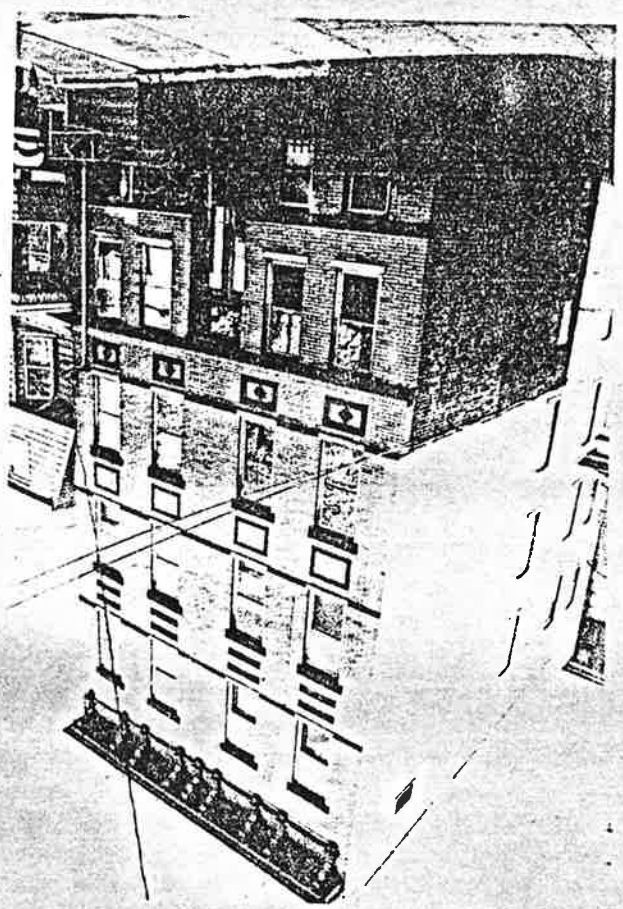

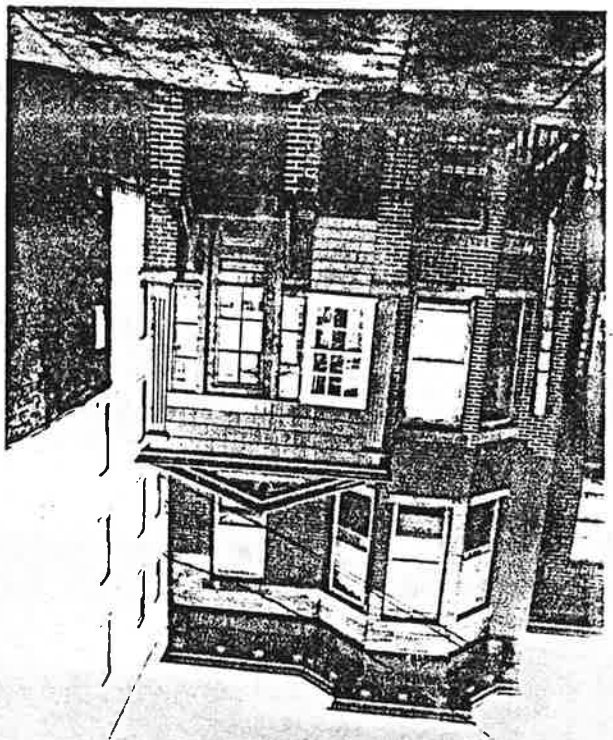

House #214 is a very altered gable roofed residence and does not contribute to the ambience of the street-scape. #'s 212 and 214 are detached, whereas #'s 216-224 are attached dwellings. Most have been re-sided and their porches altered. The early Italianate style cornices remain on 5 of the houses in the streetscape and contribute to a uniform visual impact. 1873: property of W.H.
